The objectives of the Club are:

- to grow and encourage equestrian sport in every form, both competitive and non-competitive.
- to assist in and arrange competitions and the Club may work with other recognized show holding bodies, equestrian organizations and clubs;
- to fulfill all the usual objectives of a social, cultural and sporting club which shall at all times be non-political and non-racial;
- Newmarket Stables Club has created a fee structure that is realistic in order for us to deliver on our objectives and grow the sport of horse riding so that all riders are able to register with SAEF.
- Membership of the Club is open to all persons, provided they are eligible in terms of the Constitution.

## **Questions and answers: -**

*Why join Newmarket Stables Club?*

From the 1<sup>st</sup> of August 2013, the SAEA will cease to exist and all of the SAEA disciplines will stand on their own as independent Discipline Associations Clubs will form an integral part of our sport as they provide services on behalf of the Federation such as communication and recognised participation.

*Why must a rider register with SAEF?*

It is a requirement for any SAEF registered member and a requirement of the New National Sports and recreation plan that all riders belong to a club. In order for a rider to compete or participate in any SAEF recognised events at all levels, membership is compulsory.

*Why do horses have to register with SAEF?*

So that the federation is able to keep control of all horses and passports to ensure that to ensure that their inoculations are controlled in accordance with regulations.

*Why you need to register with your disciplines?*

To keep records of the horse and riders performance history.

*What will happen to my grading points?*

The Show holding body will send your results to the disciplines concerned, where they will capture the results and issue grading points where relevant

*What is the purpose of declaring your "Primary Club" on your SAEF Rider Registration form?*

Because one can join more than one club, it is necessary to have a primary club that will be linked to your registration with SAEF, all communication with regards to your membership on the national database will be done through your primary club and that is the club that you will compete out of when being selected for teams

*What types of memberships are there for riders at Newmarket?*
